## Media Statement on Budget 2020

This is a budget which ticks all the expected boxes. There is very generous support for businesses and workers to tide us all over the effects of Covid-19. These initiatives are coupled with what is a sustained focus on further enabling businesses and workers to upgrade, grow and thrive. The message is clear: Singapore will get through the current challenges and has the financial means to do so. Concurrently, businesses and workers must maintain a clear focus on positioning themselves for future relevance and growth by continuing to transform and reskill. It was particularly satisfying to hear the assistance to facilitate training and development for business leaders and the various initiatives to enable active and purposeful ageing.

Since this may be an election year, there was considerable emphasis in the Budget announcement on, and additional generosity by way of, multi-faceted, subsidized support for citizens. All this, while exhibiting the Singapore government's traditional sustainable fiscal management. The largest budget deficit in a decade will be funded by budget surpluses achieved during the current term of government. There will be no draw on past reserves. Game, set and match.
